## Submission Guidelines

- the manuscript must not be previously published or under consideration for publication by another journal
- the manuscript must be written in English
- the manuscript should not exceed 8,000 words
- the manuscript should follow current guidelines for publication of the American Psychological Association, 6<sup>th</sup> edition
- the manuscript should use Times Roman font size 12 double-spaced
- the manuscript should be submitted in an email attachment in Microsoft Word
- the title of the submission should appear on the first page of the manuscript along with a short abstract of the article (no more than 100 words) and author information (including name[s], institutional affiliation[s] and a short biographical sketch of each author)

Manuscripts should be submitted to the email address below no later than July 1, 2011. Manuscripts that meet the standards of the publication will be reviewed by the editors. Publication decisions will be conveyed to authors via email no later than September 1, 2011.
